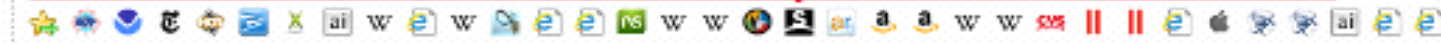

[3][4] These include [DNA cloning](#) for [sequencing](#), DNA-based [phylogeny](#), or functional analysis of [genes](#); the diagnosis of [hereditary diseases](#); the identification of [genetic fingerprints](#) (used in [forensic sciences](#) and [paternity testing](#)); and the detection and diagnosis of [infectious diseases](#). In 1993, Mullis was awarded the [Nobel Prize in Chemistry](#) along with [Michael Smith](#) for his work on PCR. [5]

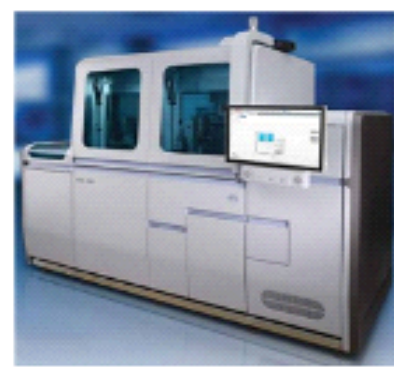

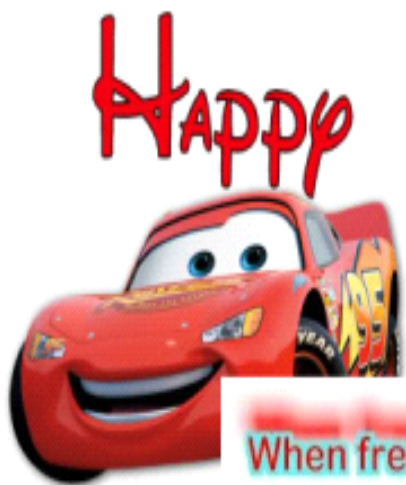

bacteriologist studying staining, a procedure that is used in many microscopic studies to make fine biological structures visible using chemical dyes. As Ehrlich injected some of these dyes (notably the aniline dyes that were then widely used), the dye stained all of the organs of some kinds of animals except for their brains. At that time, Ehrlich attributed this lack of staining to the brain simply not picking up as much of the dye. [citation needed] However, in a later experiment in 1913, Edwin Goldmann (one of Ehrlich's students) injected the dye into the cerebro-spinal fluids of animals' brains directly. He found that in this case the brains did become dyed, but the rest of the body did not. This clearly demonstrated the existence of some sort of compartmentalization between the two. At that time, it was thought that the blood vessels themselves were responsible for the barrier, since no obvious membrane could be found. The concept of the blood-brain barrier (then termed hematoencephalic barrier) was proposed by a Berlin physician, Lewandowsky, in 1900. [40] It was not until the introduction of the scanning electron microscope to the medical research fields in the 1960s that the actual membrane could be observed and proved to exist.
